- ♦ Removed learning barriers by investing in identifying learning styles of individual students and crafting accessible content delivery using a variety of modalities (video, audio, image, text, music, hands-on lab, etc). Resulted in creating a YouTube channel with 150+ hours of content and 13,000+ views on NGSS & AP Chemistry curriculum.
- ♦ Developed and mapped out the content cycle for implementing 9 units of AP Chemistry curriculum in alignment with the 2020 College Board criteria; this content is still used by teachers across the Santa Barbara Unified District.
